Now casting for "Armchair Critic," by Nicky Denovan, to be performed as part of PlayZoomers' *In the Limelight* (plays about theatre) festival on 18 and 19 October, 2024.

"Armchair Critic" is a comedy about how our aesthetic judgments are made. When Dan, the editor of a major newspaper, discovers that Clive, London's most respected critic, didn't actually attend a performance he wrote about, Clive's explanation leaves him speechless.

Casting Breakdown

DAN, m, 30s, any race or ethnicity. The editor of a national newspaper. English accent (any).

CLIVE, m, 60s, any race or ethnicity. The award-winning theatre critic of a national newspaper. Reports to Dan. English accent (RP).

Note: all actors need a current laptop computer (no phones or iPads), a taut green screen, ring light, external webcam, strong WIFI, a totally quiet rehearsal/performance space, and proficiency with Zoom controls to be eligible for these roles.

Dates and Locations

Performances on Friday, 18 October 2024 at 7:30 PM ET and Saturday, 19 October 2024 at 9:30 PM ET. Tech rehearsal on Thursday, 17 October 2024 from 6:00 PM - 9:30 PM ET. Attendance at all of these dates is required.

Other rehearsals to be determined after casting is complete in consideration of the company's schedule; most likely there will be a rehearsal commitment of about 12 hours (apart from technical rehearsals and performances).

All auditions, rehearsals, and performances to be conducted virtually by either Zoom or Ring Central apps.

Nicky Denovan (playwright) (she / her) is a UK writer. Her work has been performed in playwriting, theatre and comedy festivals in the UK, Australia, New Zealand and the US, including the finals of the Snowdance® 10-Minute Comedy Festival and the Gala Finals of Short+Sweet Theatre Sydney and Short+Sweet Theatre Hollywood. Nicky topped the British Animation Film Festival's Lottie Reiniger List 2022, which recognises screenplays of

outstanding achievement, winning Best Screenplay. Nicky's work has featured on Coverfly's industry RED LIST, and in the books *Pint-Sized Plays* Volume 5, *Best Ten Minute Plays of 2019* (published in the US by Smith & Kraus), and *Stage It*! Volume 6.
